Genesis 17:23 Then Abraham took Ishmael his son, and all the servants who were born in his house and all who were bought with his money, every male among the men of Abraham's household, and circumcised the flesh of their foreskin in the very same day, as God had said to him.

James 2:21 Was not Abraham our father justified by works, when he offered up Isaac his son on the alter? 22 You see that faith was working with his works, and as a result of the works, faith was perfected; 23 and the Scripture was fulfilled which say, "And Abraham believed God, and it was reckoned to him as righteousness," and he was called the friend of God. 24 You see that a man is justified by works, and not by faith alone.

 What is the relationship between faith & works? You don't do works to be saved; nor does salvation come from faith and works; nor is one saved by a faith without works; but salvation comes through a faith that works
